

## **REGULATION FOR VISITORS AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ADMISSION TICKETS TO THE ARCHAEOLOGICAL PARK OF THE COLOSSEUM.**

**APPROVED BY THE CDA ON OCTOBER 29, 2024**

### **Introduction**

This Regulation, adopted in compliance with the principles established by law and by the Bylaws, governs the operation and organization of the system that enables end users to purchase admission tickets to the archaeological Park of the Colosseum and is valid for the following cultural areas:

- Flavian Amphitheatre (Colosseum);
- Roman Forum;
- Palatine;
- Domus Aurea.

For the purposes of this Regulation:

- “Park” means the archaeological Park of the Colosseum;
- “Admission ticket” or “Ticket” means any entitlement to enter and stay within the archaeological sites managed by the Park;
- “Purchaser” means the person who has purchased the admission ticket to the Park;
- “User” or “Visitor” means the holder of a valid admission ticket providing the right to enter and stay within the Park;
- “Reseller” means the legal entity that owns one or more admission ticket sales systems (certified by the Italian Revenue Agency) and online or physical sales circuits, appointed by the Park to market the tickets under their own responsibility and in accordance with applicable legislation regarding sales brokerage and electronic commerce.

Each interested party agrees and undertakes to scrupulously comply with this Regulation.

### **Article 1**

#### **(Ticket purchases, changes and refunds)**

A registered Ticket is valid within the limits described by the type of ticket purchased. It must be held and retained by each visitor until the end of their tour and must be shown upon request along the route. The Ticket will be checked individually at the entrance gate by the admission control staff.

- a. The Ticket Office closes 75 minutes before the Park’s closing time (15 minutes before the last entry), with the last entry 60 minutes before the Park’s closing time.
- b. To take advantage of discounts and free tickets, you must show documentation proving your right at the ticket office before the admission ticket is issued. For free tickets purchased

online which must be mandatorily booked in advance, the documentation certifying the right to free admission will be checked at the entrance.

- c. Free admission is reserved for disabled visitors holding documentation attesting to a disability.
  - d. All Free tickets must be booked mandatorily online.
  - e. For the Colosseum underground levels, the maximum daily number of tickets that can be purchased by individual users or brokers is 8.
  - f. For Colosseum Underground guided tours, the maximum number of tickets that can be purchased per day is 8 in total, including the guide.
1. The purchasers will be solely responsible for verifying, at the time of purchase, whether there are any errors in the Colosseum tour date, time, and name for Colosseum visit, ticket type (such as, but not limited to, 24h, Full Experience, Forum Pass Super, Domus Aurea), and the number of coupons loaded in the cart. In this regard, the Park declines any and all responsibility and will provide no refunds or changes to date and time.
  2. It is strictly forbidden to transfer your Ticket against payment or to use it for brokerage, commercial, advertising or promotional purposes.
  3. Refunds will be exclusively due in the event of forced closure of the site by decision of public safety authorities as a result of natural disasters. Refunds will be made within 30 days of the scheduled date, and in any case within the period and according to the methods communicated by the Park via its website and/or social media channels. Purchasers will be responsible for obtaining information about the status of the event and required refund methods by actively viewing the Park's websites and checking information channels.
  4. By autonomous decision or following changes in applicable legislation, the Park will have the full right to:
    - a. Change the capacity of the sites;
    - b. Establish or change the admission rules to the sites (including, but not limited to, verifying admission credentials imposed by applicable legislation or otherwise required by law) which the User will be required to comply with under penalty of being denied entry.
    - c. Due to the capacity limits at the Colosseum, the duration of stay inside the monument must not exceed 75 minutes for 24H tickets and 90 minutes for Full Experience tickets. In case of exceeding these times, as verified through the recorded entry time in the system, the supervising staff may facilitate the Visitor's exit.

Purchasers and Users specifically agree and acknowledge that if the conditions set out in paragraphs a), b) and c) herein have been met, Tickets will not be refunded under any circumstances.

5. The Park will acquire the revenues from the sale of Tickets corresponding to the face price of each Ticket through the Resellers.

## **Article 2**

### **(Types of ticket that can be purchased)**

The archaeological Park of the Colosseum allows the sites mentioned in the introduction to be visited using different types of ticket for:

- private individuals and non-intermediated parties;
- organized groups with or without guided tour;
- schools and other Institutions;
- whose purchase methods are fully described in this regulation;
  
- tourist or professional operators, regarding whom please refer to the specific regulation.

Without prejudice to the maximum number of tickets that can be purchased under this regulation, each purchaser is prohibited from making more than three valid daily accesses to the authorized purchase channels. A valid access is defined as an access that concludes with the purchase of tickets.

### **Article 3**

#### **(Tickets for private individuals)**

1. Private individuals will be permitted to purchase up to 8 registered tickets per *on line* transaction, including any guide.
2. For on-site purchases, the ticket office staff will check the exact correspondence between the number of tickets issued and the number of users present at the time of purchase, in any case, each transaction allows for the issuance of a maximum of 8 tickets.
3. Tickets purchased *on site* allow access to the Colosseum exclusively through the individual visitor entrance. If a guided tour service is associated with these tickets, it remains mandatory that the purchase of each individual ticket is completed solely by the end user. The group may consist of a maximum of 8 individual visitors, including the guide, who will enter the Colosseum through the individual entrance. It is understood that simultaneous access is not permitted for groups of people who have purchased tickets with different entry time slots, even if they are close in timing.
4. When purchasing the Ticket, each user will be required to enter their personal identification data associating them with the Ticket. In this case, Purchasers and Users acknowledge that their identities will be checked at the entrance. Users will be required to show the original copy of their identity document together with the admission ticket. Admission will be denied in the event of failure to comply with this paragraph and in such a case no refunds will be made. The sales system allows the names of visitors stated on the Ticket to be changed directly online only once. This operation is permitted up to one week before the tour, i.e. precisely by midnight of the seventh day prior to the date the Ticket is to be used. If the names entered in the ticketing platform do not match the users' identities on each admission ticket, entry to the Park will be denied and no refunds will be made.
5. Also with reference to the preceding point, Purchasers will be responsible for the truthfulness of the personal data entered at the time of purchase or subsequently modified, among other things, with reference to names, surnames, dates of birth and contact details (email address and/or telephone number) of the User of each admission ticket, and will be liable in the event of a false statement or misrepresentation, as pursuant to Article 76 of Presidential Decree No. 445/2000.
6. In the case of intermediated purchases made through non-accredited agencies or entities, the Park reserves the right to deny access to the Users, while still allowing them the option to

purchase a new valid access ticket at the local ticket offices. The Park also reserves the right to report such non-accredited agencies or entities to the competent authorities.

7. Tickets issued *on site* during free admission days are to be considered of the type described in this article.

#### **Article 4**

##### **(Tickets for groups)**

Groups will be permitted to purchase up to 25 registered tickets.

1. For the Colosseum Forum Palatine 24h and Forum Pass Super ticket types, excluding a tour guide, the limit is set for each transaction through the online channel. For Full Experience Arena, Only Arena, and Arena Underground tickets, the limit is 25, including the tour guide. For all tickets that include Super Sites for the visit, capacity rules apply as outlined in the Appendix. At the time of purchase, the group organizer will be required to enter the personal identification data of each group member for each Ticket.
2. The group organizer acknowledges that their identities will be checked at the entrance and group members will be required to show the original copy of their identity document together with the admission ticket. Admission will be denied in the event of failure to comply with this paragraph and in such a case no refunds will be made. The sales system allows the names of visitors stated on the Ticket to be changed directly online only once. This operation is permitted up to one week before the tour, i.e. precisely by midnight of the seventh day prior to the date the Ticket is to be used. If the names entered in the ticketing platform do not match the users' identities on each admission ticket, entry to the Park will be denied and no refunds will be made.
3. Audio devices, if any, must be distributed before entering the sites to avoid hindering the flow of visitors at the entrance.
4. Groups must stay together, follow their guide or teacher/accompanying party and behave appropriately and respectfully, as per regulation.
5. During the guided tour, the group's tone of voice must be such as not to disturb other visitors.
6. For groups consisting of 9 (nine) or more people, including the guide, the use of earphones (Whisper devices) allowing any accompanying parties to keep their tone of voice low is mandatory. Otherwise, those accompanying the group will not be able to explain the monument.

#### **Article 5**

##### **(Tickets for tourist guides and rules of conduct, prohibitions and penalties)**

1. Practising the profession of tourist guide within the Park is permitted exclusively to professional guides, in accordance with applicable legislation.
2. The staff in charge of admission control will check the guide's name and the validity of the documentation.

3. Unaccredited tour guides at the Park are granted a free named ticket, which can be booked exclusively online and is valid for 3 daily entries without time restrictions (in the form of 3 daily tickets), which may be used for access to the Colosseum via the standard route. For the Colosseum Underground, the Attic, and the Arena level, it will always be necessary to book a free ticket for guides online, even for guides accredited by the Park.
4. The guide will be ready at the entrance to accompany the group to the relevant site at least 15 minutes before the time indicated on the Ticket, adhering to the time regulations for each specific ticket type. For the Full Experience Underground ticket type, it is necessary to enter the Colosseum 30 minutes before the time indicated on the Ticket.
5. The group organizer will be responsible for the truthfulness of the personal data entered at the time of purchase or subsequently modified, among other things, with reference to names, surnames, dates of birth and contact details (email address and/or telephone number) of the User of each admission ticket, and will be liable in the event of a false statement or misrepresentation, as pursuant to Article 76 of Presidential Decree No. 445/2000.
6. The guide must adopt correct behaviour providing cooperation to the organization that is responsible for safeguarding the cultural and environmental heritage, as well as towards the custodial, supervisory, ticketing, and reception staff of the sites and archaeological areas.
7. In carrying out their functions, tour guides must use the tools provided by the Park and/or required by law (Park Guide Pass and/or free tickets).
8. For the visit to the Colosseum, concerning the duration of the visit, it is at the discretion of the tour guide to propose to Visitors a route limited to the visit of only the 1st order, provided that they assume responsibility by completing the designated form available at the Colosseum Coordinators' office.
9. Tour guides are subject to the provisions of Article 9 of this regulation.

## **Article 6**

### **(Tickets for schools)**

1. EU and non-EU Schools and other Institutions are allowed to purchase tickets within the limit of 30 people per group.
2. For European schools, after the tour has been booked, free access will be granted to any accompanying teachers who provide their identification, including any third-party guides for educational services.  
Free admission also applies to minors under 18 years old from non-European educational institutions, while no free admission is provided for accompanying adults.  
Following booking, entry will be permitted for accompanying parties upon submission of a list of names of students and accompanying teachers divided by class and signed by the school director on the school's headed paper.
3. If school tickets instead of regular group tickets have been booked erroneously or the required conditions are no longer satisfied \ documentation is missing, entry to the monument area will be denied and the correct entry tickets will need to be purchased, subject to availability.  
The school group organizer acknowledges that their identities will be checked at the entrance: for European school groups, school lists and related documents will be checked while for non-

European school groups, access passes will be checked and group members will be required to show an original identity document at the same time as the access pass.

4. The group's guide service, if any, must be reported at the time of purchase by entering the necessary data to complete the procedure.
5. Also with reference to the preceding point, the school group organizer will be responsible for the truthfulness of the personal data entered at the time of purchase or subsequently modified, among other things, with reference to names, surnames, dates of birth and contact details (email address and/or telephone number) of the User of each admission ticket, and will be liable in the event of a false statement or misrepresentation, as pursuant to Article 76 of Presidential Decree No. 445/2000.
6. Educational institutions must access the archaeological area of the Roman Forum-Palatine from Via di San Gregorio 30 or from Roman Forum 1 (La Piccola).
7. Educational institutions that intend to use agencies or tour operators must delegate them using the appropriate form available online in the schools section; failure to do so will result in the inability to take advantage of legal benefits.

## **Article 7**

### **(Entry to the Park)**

1. Tickets must be shown together with an identification document at the entrance gates (under Article 18 of Legislative Decree No. 60/99) under penalty of being denied entry.
2. Children under the age of 12 may enter the Park only if accompanied by an adult holding the appropriate admission Ticket. The admission of minors between the ages of 12 and 18 unaccompanied by an adult is permitted but will be considered to be under the exclusive responsibility and at the sole risk of their parents or persons exercising authority over the minor; the Park declines any responsibility with respect to minors who have been admitted to the Park without an adult accompanying party.
3. Admission to the Colosseum alone is according to time slots, here are the procedures:
  - a. The holder of the Colosseum 24H and Full Experience Arena tickets must arrive at least 15 minutes before the time indicated on the ticket and no later than 15 minutes after.
  - b. The holder of the Full Experience Underground and Arena tickets must arrive at least 30 minutes before the time indicated on the ticket, with no tolerance for delays.
  - c. The holder of the 24H Only Arena and Full Experience Attic tickets must arrive at least 15 minutes before the time indicated on the ticket, with no tolerance for delays.
4. If Users fail to respect the time restrictions stated in this article, their Ticket may no longer be used for the Colosseum, but only for one admission to the Roman Forum-Palatine, unless previously used. No refunds will be due to Purchasers.
5. In the event of theft or loss, it will not be permitted to duplicate, obtain a refund for, or replace the admission Ticket under any circumstances.
6. For security reasons, checks will be carried out with metal detectors at the time of admission. Therefore, to speed up the queue, please remove any unauthorized objects from your hand luggage in advance (see Rules of Conduct and Prohibitions, point 5 below).
7. Hand luggage must not exceed the following dimensions: 30x40x15. The Park does not have a cloakroom or luggage storage.



## **Article 8**

### **(General conditions)**

1. Failure to comply with any clauses contained herein will imply the prohibition to enter the Park, without the right to a refund of the Tickets.
2. By purchasing the Access Ticket, each User fully agrees to the conditions stated herein.
3. Purchasers and Users hereby agree to this Regulation and any additional clauses published: on the Park's websites; and in the presentation or purchase form of the Event on the Reseller's website.
4. The manager verifies compliance by Buyers with the provisions set forth in this regulation, and in the event of a confirmed violation, will take prompt action against the individual concerned. In cases of repeated violations of the provisions of this regulation, particularly regarding repeated purchases or behaviours related to Article 1, point 2, the manager, in the absence of valid justifications, will not allow the identified user to proceed with further purchases. The manager will then suspend access to the purchasing channels and notify the user of the initiation of the proceedings, inviting them to submit their comments within three days. In the absence of valid justifications, the manager will terminate access to the purchasing channels associated with the account.

## **Article 9**

### **(Rules of conduct, prohibitions and penalties)**

1. The Park encompasses a vast archaeological area that includes the Colosseum, the Roman Forum, the Palatine and the Domus Aurea. Most of the surface within this area is uneven and is accessible via historical routes that are often bumpy and with many differences in height. Ancient stairs are not level. Furthermore, the Flavian Amphitheatre has very steep stairways and paths that are sometimes uneven and bumpy. During your visit, in addition to wearing proper footwear, always pay close attention to the route along the way and follow the rules set out below.
2. Visitors are not permitted to leave the designated routes and must only follow routes and prepared walkways open to the public. They must supervise their children following the instructions of the reception staff, without engaging in behaviour that is dangerous for themselves and for other visitors. Moreover, it is forbidden to enter areas closed to the public; run around the archaeological area; climb walls and jump over fences leaving the tour route; lean over parapets and railings; throw waste outside the designated containers; eat meals except within permitted areas (not present at the Colosseum); smoking (including electronic cigarettes); light fires; arrange for guided tours by soliciting participants within the Park; carry out

commercial activities of any nature; sing songs or utter abusive remarks; enter the area wearing ceremonial attire, masks or costumes; display banners, flags and standards or any material bearing distinctive and/or advertising insignia, without the prior authorization of the Park.

3. Only guide dogs or dogs used for therapeutic purposes are allowed inside the Colosseum and in closed areas, provided they are accompanied by medical certification. The open areas of the Roman Forum and Palatine may be accessed with small dogs (weighing less than 10 kg) exclusively in the appropriate carrier.
4. Entry to the Park will be permitted if Visitors wear proper clothing and closed footwear suitable for the rough paths that characterize the sites. The Archaeological Park of the Colosseum assumes no responsibility for any damage resulting from the use of improper and/or unsuitable clothing.
5. It is strictly forbidden to write on the walls or on materials on display, damage or remove archaeological material, touch the objects displayed in the Park Museums (unless specifically created for such purpose), climb on capitals, columns or blocks present in the area. Any damage caused will be reported to the competent Judicial Authorities and punished under Law No. 6 of January 22, 2024, concerning sanctions related to the destruction, damage, defacement, and vandalism of cultural and landscape heritage, respectively:
  - With an administrative financial penalty ranging from €20,000 to €60,000 for anyone who destroys, disperses, deteriorates, or renders wholly or partially unusable, or where applicable, inaccessible, cultural or landscape heritage belonging to themselves or others;
  - With an administrative financial penalty ranging from €10,000 to €40,000 for anyone who defaces or vandalizes cultural or landscape heritage belonging to themselves or others, or who subjects cultural heritage to uses detrimental to their conservation or integrity, or to uses incompatible with their historical or artistic character.
6. It is not permitted to bring into the Park firearms or cutting weapons, blades, knives, multi-purpose weapons and tools capable of causing harm to people or damage to property; glass bottles; trekking poles; falls, backpacks, suitcases and trolleys exceeding the permitted dimensions; umbrellas not exceeding one meter in size, bicycles, scooters and other vehicles; spray or gas cans; laser pointers, loudspeakers or other sound amplification tools, viewers of any type; selfie sticks (check helmets, shoulder carriers, and other items for children, as well as anything else not specified but that we know may be subject to discussion).
7. The use of professional optical and audio equipment (tripods, cameras, microphones, audio mixers, etc.) and drones (remotely piloted aircraft, RPVs) is also prohibited in the absence of formal authorization from the Colosseum archaeological Park Management. Any actions contrary to these prohibitions will be reported to the competent Judicial and/or Public Security Authorities.
8. The sale of entry tickets by parties not authorized by the Park is also prohibited.
9. At the entrance gates, scanner controls and metal detectors will be in operation for the security of the Park visitors.
10. The security staff regulates the access of visitors, companions, and tour guides to the areas of the Park by issuing directives and instructions deemed necessary in compliance with this regulation and any specific provisions issued by the Park Management.
11. According to this regulation, anyone intending to access the areas of the Park is required to follow the instructions given pursuant to paragraph 10 and/or to conduct themselves in accordance with standard civic etiquette, showing respect towards the staff working within the Park and maintaining good conduct.



12. The service personnel is responsible for prohibiting access to the areas of the Park for anyone (visitors, companions, guides) who exhibits behaviour contrary to the indications and provisions of this regulation.
13. Anyone accompanying a group of people within the monuments of the Park is required to carry out their activities from the entrance until the exit, avoiding leaving individuals along the route.
14. A tour guide who is unable to provide the service for which they have booked their entry ticket must delegate a substitute using the appropriate form available for download on the websites [colosseo.it](http://colosseo.it) and [ticketing.colosseo.it](http://ticketing.colosseo.it). A maximum of one daily delegation is allowed for the following types of tickets: 24H, Full Experience Arena, and Forum Pass Super. For the types of tickets Full Experience Underground and Arena, 24H Only Arena, and Full Experience Attic, only one weekly delegation is permitted. It is understood that on the day the tour guide wishes to be replaced, they may not book other access tickets or be delegated by other individuals.
15. As part of the Park's efforts to combat illegal activities, particularly regarding the profession of tour guide, any personnel associated with the Park may conduct checks and may remove individuals who, in the absence of a recognition badge, cannot demonstrate their role within the group.
16. In the event of a violation of this regulation by escorts, tourist guides, and any other user of the Park, the staff will report the conduct to the Park Management and the relevant authorities in light of this regulation.

## **Article 10**

### **(Obligations and responsibilities)**

- 1) When enjoying the Park areas and related facilities, users are required to comply with applicable legal provisions and this Regulation.
- 2) Without prejudice to criminal prosecution and administrative liability, visitors will be civilly liable towards the Park for any damage caused due to carelessness, imprudence or failure to comply with the obligations and prohibitions set out herein. The accompanying parties of groups and school children are responsible for ensuring compliance by individuals with this Regulation.
- 3) The Park reserves the right to remove visitors who do not respect the obligations and prohibitions set out herein.

## **ANNEX: TICKETS**

The various types of ticket currently sold by the Archaeological Park of the Colosseum are listed below.

### **24H COLOSSEUM, ROMAN FORUM - PALATINE**

The ticket includes a single entry with a reserved time for the Colosseum (I and II order), excluding the arena floor, and a single entry to the archaeological areas of the Roman Forum-Palatine and the Imperial Fora, including any ongoing exhibitions, without a predetermined time, as long as it is within the 24 hours preceding or following the reserved time for the Colosseum.

## **24H ONLY ARENA**

The ticket includes a single entry with a reserved time for the Colosseum and an exit from the Sperone Stern side, with a visit only to the arena floor. It also includes access to the Roman Forum, the Palatine Hill, the Super sites, the Imperial Fora, and any ongoing exhibitions, provided it is within the 24 hours preceding or following the reserved time for the Colosseum. Access is allowed for 50 people every 20 minutes, and the maximum permitted stay on the arena floor is 20 minutes.

## **FULL EXPERIENCE**

**There are three types of ticket:**

**Full Experience Arena** – The ticket is valid for 2 consecutive days and includes a single entry with a reserved time for the Colosseum and access to the reconstructed portion of the arena on the eastern side, as well as entry to the Roman Forum, the Palatine Hill, the Super sites, and the Imperial Fora, including any ongoing exhibitions, on the day before or after the reserved time for the Colosseum.

**Full Experience Underground and Arena** – The ticket is valid for 2 consecutive days and includes a single entry with a reserved time for the Colosseum, including access to the undergrounds and the reconstructed portion of the arena on the eastern side. It also grants entry to the Roman Forum, the Palatine Hill, the Super sites, and the Imperial Fora, including any ongoing exhibitions, on the day before or after the reserved time for the Colosseum.

Access to the undergrounds is allowed in guided groups of a maximum of 25 people every 15 minutes.

For this type of ticket purchased as part of the special event “A Night at the Colosseum,” it is specified that the visit to the archaeological area of the Roman Forum-Palatine can take place either on the same day as the event or the following day.

**Full Experience Attic** - The ticket is valid for 2 consecutive days and includes a single entry with a reserved time for the Colosseum, which includes a visit via the panoramic elevator to the intermediate gallery between the II and III tiers, and from there to the attic. It also grants entry to the Roman Forum, the Palatine Hill, the Super sites, and the Imperial Fora, including any ongoing exhibitions, on the day before or after the reserved time for the Colosseum.

## **SUPER FORUM PASS: ROMAN FORUM - PALATINE + SUPER SITES**
