Daycare Terms & Liability Notice (Summary)

The following outlines the main liability and operational policies applicable to the use of KiDO Thonglor daycare services. These policies are acknowledged by parents/guardians prior to the use of the service and formally agreed upon at the daycare facility upon arrival.

1. Emergency Medical Authorization

Parents/guardians grant KiDO permission to provide first aid and obtain emergency medical treatment for the child if the parent/guardian cannot be reached or if a delay could endanger the child.

If necessary, the child may be taken to the nearest hospital for treatment. Any medical expenses incurred will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian.

2. Limitation of Liability

The liability of KiDO Daycare to the child or parents/guardians shall be limited to the total amount of service fees paid for the childcare service.

3. Operational Authority

KiDO reserves the right to organize and manage daycare services, activities, and supervision in a manner deemed appropriate by the management for the safety and wellbeing of all children in the facility.

4. Health and Safety Policies

Parents/guardians are responsible for informing KiDO of any medical conditions, allergies, or special needs of the child prior to the use of the service.

Children showing symptoms of contagious illness or conditions that may affect other children may not be admitted to the daycare.

5. Personal Belongings

KiDO is not responsible for loss or damage to personal belongings brought into the facility.

6. Agreement to Terms

By making a reservation for the daycare service, parents/guardians acknowledge that they have read and understood the operational policies and agree to comply with the daycare's rules and procedures.

The official consent form will be completed and signed by the parent/guardian upon arrival at the daycare facility.
